- Wrench
- Socket

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The Parts









Set up

Place base on a sturdy table with the label facing up - you should not be able to see the silver nut parts set into the base.





Assemble sides

Place parts A and C in the left and right slots as shown.

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3 Assemble neck parts


- Supporting the sides with one hand to prevent them tipping forward.
- Slot neck assembly into first row of slots



4 Install center part

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5 Install neck bolt

- Locate large bolt and nut (M12)
- Place in holes and install nut finger tight only.



6 Install support

Slide in support part



Install triscrews

- Ensure holes on support part are aligned with hole on base.
- Screw in Triscrews on both sides.

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 Install center spine into neck part and slot on base. Continue to support to prevent tipping







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Install throat assembly

 Slide in throat assemby to horse head in the orientation shown.



10 Install and tighten bolts

- Install bolts through holes in horse head and throat assembly.
- Tighten nuts to a loose hand tightness.
- Do not overtighten.



Install horse head on neck assembly

- Slide horse head onto neck tube.
- If you are having trouble aligning the tube with the hole, try tilting the horse head forward slightly.
- Trachea tube should be in the center of the neck.

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12 Check fit

• Ensure the tube hits a firm stop and the head is fully seated on the neck.



13 Attach throat arms to cross bolt

 Take arms coming off throat box and align the concave end with the cross bolt and attach



Align right side fleece

• The top of the fleece should align with the top of the plywood side as shown.

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install oesophegus tube in fleece (if not already)





- Unit should arrive with oesophagus pipe already assembled. If so, skip to step 17.
- If not, follow the instructions below.
- Fold pipe over to help it remain rigid as you feed it.
- Start pushing free end of tube into the gap between the fleece and the foam. Ensure you have the right side fleece as shown above.
- Keep pushing tube through cavity until you see it at the other end of the fleece cavity.
- Unfold and flatten out the tube, ensuring there are no twists.

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16 Align left side fleece

• The top of the fleece should align with the top of the plywood side as shown.



17 Attach oesophagus onto throat assembly

Slide oesophagus onto throat box tube as shown.

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18 Secure oesophagus

Secure tube with adjustable zip tie/cable tie/zap strap.



19 Attach end of oesophagus

- Locate the end of the oesophagus.
- Push in between side and centre part, secure bungee cords in slots.
- Ensure there are no twists in the oesophegus.

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20 Secure fleece

 Again, aligning fleece to plywood, secure fleece to frame.



21 Check fleece

• Check fleece is well aligned and attached.

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Operating Instructions

Equipment Required:

- Nasogastric Intubation Tube (not provided)
- Suitable Lubricant



- 1 Apply lubricant and insert tube into nostril
 - Either nostril can be used.



- 2 Lower head to feed pipe into oesophagus
 - Push down on the nose with firm pressure to direct the pipe into the oesophagus.

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Raise head to feed pipe into trachea

 Pull the chin up with firm pressure to open the mechanical epiglottis and feed the pipe into the trachea.

4 Clean up

- clean with warm soapy water to clean nostrils through to oesophagus sleeve.
- This is to stop the lube drying out and creating blockages.

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
